Dear Contractors and contract workers,

You are invited and encouraged to attend a Business Development Opportunities & Resources Orientation that features Lac Du Flambeau Tribal Construction Projects that we intend to implement in 2015. Lac du Flambeau projects will be highlighted and explained at 10 a.m. at the Lake of the Torches Casino Resort – Sokaogon Room. We will also explain the Native Preference policy, LdF Native American Hiring Process, Native American Subcontracting and Local Labor. We plan on implementing and constructing the following roads and projects this year:

1. Complete Asaawee Lane - ongoing project
2. Bid second layer of asphalt and some reconstruction on Dental Clinic Parking lot.
3. Construct a public dock at the Bear River Dam area on lakeside.
4. Clear, Grub, grade and gravel Leach Lane that leads to a recreational area.
5. Improve and construct a gravel road on Schilleman Road Extension. This may be a fall project.
6. Rusty Lane, a small asphalt road with some clearing that leads to a small subdivision.
7. Sugar Bush Trail is several miles of pulverizing, new gravel, asphalt and some guardrail work.
8. White Feather Road project is to add parking along an existing road, removing a short curb, lowering a manhole, cutting down a tree and restoration around the newly renovated historic Boys Dorm.
9. Reconstruction and expansion of Fence Lake Landing, Parking, and pier.
10. We also plan to begin construction on a new Youth Center with a large gymnasium. Architectural plans have to be finalized yet.
11. The Waaswaganing Indian Bowl and Cultural Center will also begin this year after final plans as a phased project.
12. An addition will be added to the Tribal Roads Dept. Garage making more room for transit buses.
13. We are also making application for several water and sewer projects.

Note: Other Statewide Projects and Indian Projects will also be reference later in the day (e.g. see agenda at registration link).

Again, you are welcome to attend and hopefully bid on the projects when they are let. Most of the road projects will be advertised in a few weeks. We want to work together to have quality projects. Please find the agenda for the whole day at registration link. Lunch is provided but would like an RSVP as soon as possible for a count. Again, please register as indicated at the link below. Thanks and have a safe and prosperous construction season.
