



Contracting for Services, Supplies, Construction, Medical Services, Leases and Prosthetics is done regionally by a Network Contract Office (NCO) The Veterans Integrated Staffing Networks (VISN) and Network Contract Offices (NCO) are numbered 1 thru 23. Great Lakes is "Region 12". NCO 12 is also known as the Great Lakes Acquisition Center or "GLAC", which is the centralized contracting office for region 12.

GREAT LAKES ACQUISITION CENTER (GLAC)

The GLAC is the regional contracting office, also known as Netw Office (NCO) 12, servicing the geographic region listed above. GLAC personnel procure vital supplies, services, healthcare resources, construction, lease services and prosthetics IAW the Federal Acquisition Regulation & the VA Acq. Regulation.

HINT: It's important to note when encountering VA personnel, that only a warranted Contracting Officer can obligate the Government's money. To initiate a contract requirement, VA personnel should submit their request through the assigned NCO, for example in VISN 12, the GLAC (NCO 12).

Where to find opportunities?

When not using an existing contract vehicle, such as those discussed in the box to the right, the VM posts opportunities of prices as like as to be such that the contract of posts of

HINT: Set & save your advanced searches as "search agents" to send you daily or weekly emails when new opportunities post. Tweak advanced searches often if you are getting no hits.

Lastly, procurements to various General Services Administration schedules (see box to the right) are posted at GSA's e-Buy site.

The Veterans First program

Capability Statement

Once registered at the Government site <u>SAM</u>, you are ready to let VISN 12 know what you have to offer. This can best be done by creating a corpolity statement and emailing it to the <u>small business illusion</u> with a little introductory paragraph about your company.

Much like a resume' when applying for a job, a Capability Statement is your company profile in a quick and concise 1-2 page format for easy reference for Government buyers. At a minimum include the following:

- minimum include the following:

 Company name & logo w/key personnel contact info and website address.
- DUNS #, any small business certs or designations & applicable NAICS.
- Summary of products and services (core competencies) Any specific gov't contracts or projects you have worker

VA Existing Contracts/Mandatory Sources

In addition to the Federal Government's commitment to do-ning business with small business, it is important to under-stand that there are also pre-negotisted contracts on a VA (or Government) wide scale to allow MCDs to take advantage of commonise of zools in negotiating better pricing for the tax-paper dollar. VA will look to use contract vehicles like these before creating new contracts for items in categories such as:

Medical Supplies & Equipment: Medical/Surgical Prime Ven-dor, GSA Schedule 65 II A. High Tech Medical Equipment as well as Standardization contracts and Pharmacy Prime Vendor.
