- Was about 7,000 square feet
- Treated 3,500 veterans annually

New Clinic Facts



- Opened in August 2013
- Nearly 162,000 square feet
- Currently treating 8,500 veterans
- Will grow to about 10,000 within the year
- Approximately 250 employees

New Clinic Facts



- Voluntary Service is active with state/local governments, outside organizations, and nonprofits
- Mental Health staff nearly doubled from 11 to 21 in the new clinic
- Surgeons recently started to perform outpatient procedures and colonoscopies

- Served as a Private in the US Army, 551st Parachute Infantry Battalion.
- For 2 days in December of 1944, Milo was literally a one-man army. He singlehandedly waged war against the Germans.
- Awarded the Distinguished Service Cross.
- Lived in Brown County.
- Wisconsin's most highly decorated veteran of World War II.
