



Huntington Ingalls Industries, Pascagoula, Mississippi, is being awarded a \$43,569,211 fixed-price incentive (firm target), undefinitized contract action modification to previously awarded contract N00024-13-C-2307 for long lead time material and associated non-recurring engineering and pre-production activities required to support ship construction efforts for the DDG-125 ship. Work will be performed in Pascagoula, Mississippi (26.9 percent); Indianapolis, Indiana (20.1 percent); York, Pennsylvania (16 percent); **Milwaukee, Wisconsin (15.7 percent)**; High Ridge, Missouri (9.2 percent); Saratoga Springs, New York (8 percent); and Shreveport, Louisiana (4.1 percent), and is expected to be completed by July 2022. Fiscal 2017 shipbuilding and conversion (Navy) funding in the amount of \$32,676,908 will be obligated at time of award and will not expire at the end of the current fiscal year. The Naval Sea Systems Command, Washington, District of Columbia, is the contracting activity.
