## **Seeking College Scholarship Candidates**

### **COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY**

(Great Lakes, IL) The Lake Michigan Post of The Society of American Military Engineers will award college scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to \$3,000 for the 2017-2018 school year. Applicants must be a graduating high school student, full-time undergraduate college student or graduate student at an accredited college or university during the 2016-2017 school year and must be pursuing an undergraduate degree in engineering, architecture, or an environmental or applied science (i.e. mathematics, physics, chemistry, geology, etc.) with the ultimate goal of pursuing a career in construction, engineering, architecture, environmental science, or a physical science associated with these career fields. The major emphasis for this scholarship is to support the physical elements of community life such as buildings, highways, utility and mechanical systems, and those technologies which advance the community's well being.
