

- 2. Chicago Secures \$1 Billion in Federal Grant Funding for Rail Upgrades January 10, 2017 Chicago's Transit Authority will receive nearly \$1.1 billion in federal grant funding to help pay for upgrades meant to expand rail capacity on the north side of the city, officials said Monday.

The money will go toward roughly \$2.1 billion of planned work on the city's Red and Purple "L" lines. This will include improvements to track, stations, power and signal systems, and the purchase of 32 new railcars, according to the Federal Transit Administration.

3. Secure That Smart Toaster and Win \$3,000- January 4, 2017 The Federal Trade Commission is offering up to \$25,000 in prize money for applications or tools that help people protect their smart home devices from hackers, according to a Federal Register notice.

The competition, which will announce winners in July, comes as the internet is creeping into more and more household devices ranging from baby monitors to toasters.

These internet-of-things devices are often less secure than traditional internet-connected devices such as laptops and smartphones. It's also often more difficult to update the software in these devices to patch vulnerabilities, making

## How does FPDS differ from USAspending?

- FPDS provides data once a month to USAspending
- USAspending provides information on
  - Contracts
  - Loans
  - Grants
  - Subcontracts
- USAspending used to have a better User interface
- FPDS adhoc query lets the user access every data element and create filters



## What is FPDS

- Database of Federal Contract awards (> \$3,000.00) \*
- \*Unclassified, other restrictions, -- will often include awards <\$3,000.00
- Information categories
  - Metrics things that are measured
    - Examples
      - Action Obligation
      - Actions
      - Number of Records
  - Attributes characteristics of Metrics (approximately 300 data elements)
    - Examples (general)
      - Who purchased agency, department, contracting office
      - What was purchased NAICS/PSC/Description of Requirement
      - Size of business Large or Small



### **FPDS** data

- DoD data
  - 90 days delayed for non-government users
- Non-DoD data
  - Effectively live
- Data is subject to adjustments
  - Contract modifications
  - Deobligations items negative/red
- PIID should be unique contract number procurement identifier
  - 20 year lifetime
- Standard format Some organizations seem to do a better job than others

- Maximum, five years of results
- Or
- 30,000 results
- Data presentation / format
- As is from FPDS the data is difficult to use or make sense of
- Limited formatting capability












