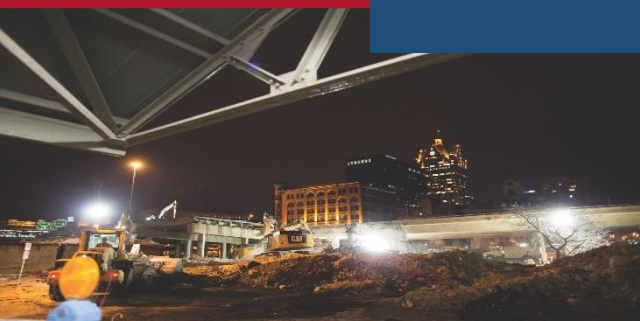

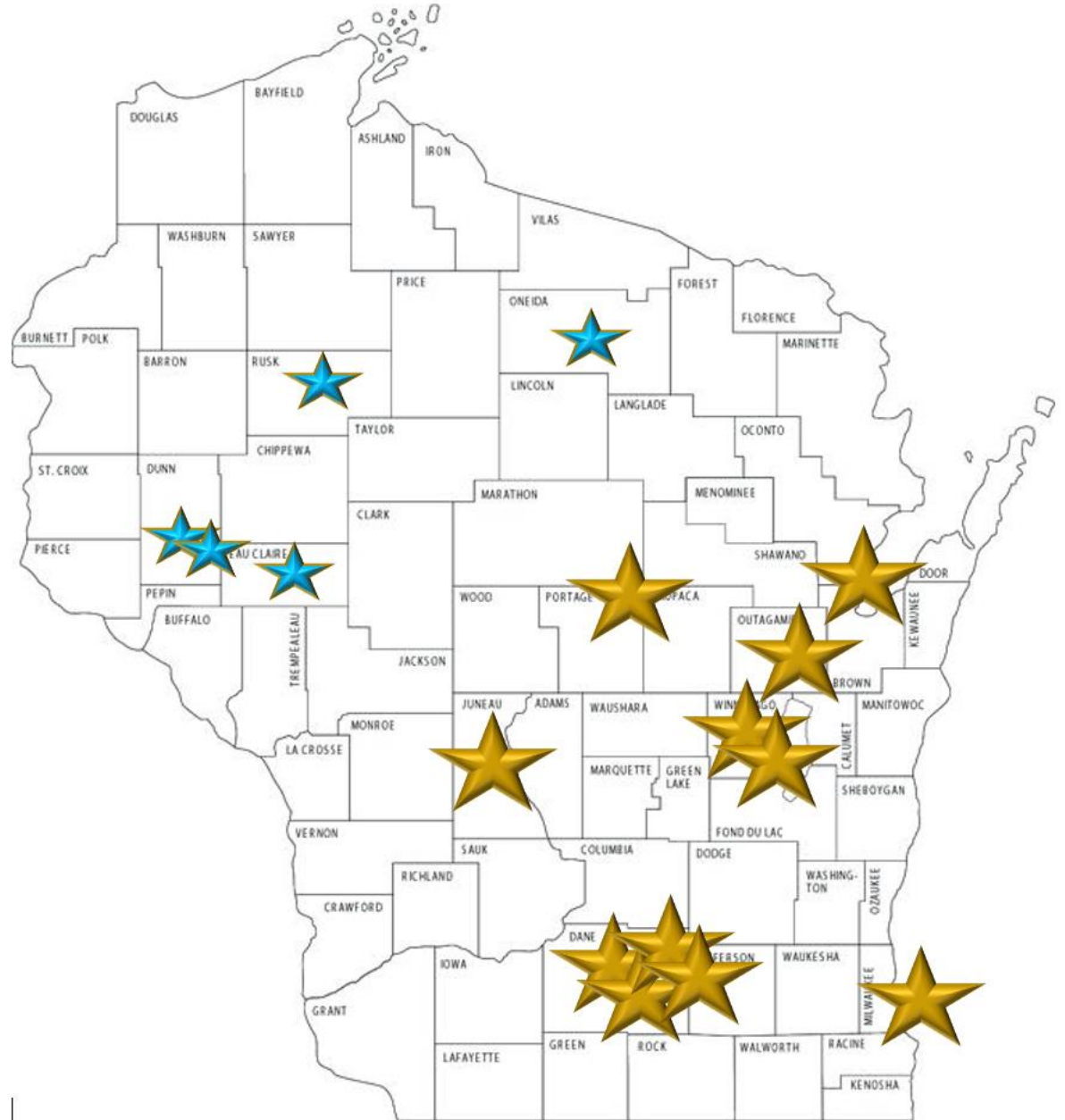

STATE PROCUREMENT

STATE PROCUREMENT PROCESS

State laws require the use of the bid process whenever possible to promote free and open competition while allowing the state to pay the best price for an appropriate product. This is accomplished by awarding the solicitation to the lowest responsible bidder.

The State of Wisconsin adjusted its bid levels from time to time to streamline the purchasing process for state agencies and vendors.

For best judgment and simplified bidding procurements, agencies make a special effort to award to small businesses, service-disabled veteran-owned businesses, minority businesses, and work centers.

STATE PROCUREMENT PROCESS

Purchases of \$5000 or less

Purchases may be made from vendors who, according to the best judgment of the purchasing agent, can supply the item of appropriate quality at a reasonable price.

Purchases over \$5000 through \$50,000

The purchasing agent compares three or more bids from at least three or more bidders, whenever possible, from price lists, quotes on file, phone or verbal quotes, or written bids. The low bid price should be confirmed in writing by the vendor.

Over \$50,000

At this level, a formal process is used. Solicitations are advertised on the State of Wisconsin Public Notices website. In addition, the solicitations are posted on VendorNet.

Non-Discrimination in State Contracts Per 2019 Wisconsin Executive Order 1

Per 2019 Wisconsin Executive Order 1, state agencies and campuses have new requirements related to non-discrimination in state contracting.

The Department of Administration has adjusted standard terms and conditions to reflect these changes, and has published policy which provides direction on the procedures agencies will follow to ensure compliance.

Procurement Information Memorandum (PIM) 19-003: Non-Discrimination in State Contracts Per 2019 Wisconsin Executive Order 1 has been posted to the Index of PIMs found in the Procurement Manual, Section PRO-B-10. New versions of forms DOA-3054 (Standard Terms and Conditions (RFB/RFP)), DOA-3054A (Standard Terms and Conditions (Purchase Order) and DOA-3832 (Bidder Required Form) have also been posted to the VendorNet Forms page.

Prohibition of Discriminatory Boycotts of Israel in State Contracting

Per §16.75(10p), Wis. Stats., state agencies and campuses will not enter into a contract with a company that is participating in a prohibited boycott. This requirement affects contracts valued over \$100,000.

Duties

Duties of the County Clerk are prescribed by statute and include:

- **County Board:** Prepares and maintains County Board agendas, minutes, resolutions, ordinances, appointments, and legal notices.
- **Elections:** coordinates federal, state and county elections. Supplies ballots for elections.
- **Code of Ordinances:** Maintains updated Juneau County code of ordinances.
- **County Directory:** maintains and prepares a county directory of local officials, and county agencies and departments.
- **Zoning:** Maintains records of county ordinances that impact zoning.
- **Farmland Preservation:** Maintains copies of applications.
- **Property:** lease, sell, or convey or contract to sell county property designated by the County Board. Provide affidavits as necessary to clear titles to property previously held by the county.
- **Oaths and Bonds:** issues and maintains oaths and bonds and certificates of election for all county officials.
- **Purchasing:** performs purchasing duties as prescribed by the county board.
- **School Records:** acts as custodian of record for the County Superintendent of Schools.
- **Census:** Assist the federal census every ten years. Review annexation maps.
- **Certified Survey Maps:** county clerk signs and distributes approved certified survey maps.
