Through the GSA Multiple Award Schedule (MAS) program long-term government wide contracts between commercial suppliers and the government providing federal, state, and local government buyers access to millions of commercial supplies (products) and services at volume discount pricing.

All NAICS codes can be purchased through the MAS program with the exception of design and construction acquisition and engineering and architecture projects which are purchased through GSA's Public Buildings Service (PBS). Holding a Schedule contract can open doors for businesses, but it requires effort and commitment on your part to succeed.

Upcoming projects or initiatives that may require small business program participation:

All GSA design and construction contracting opportunities are advertised on the Federal Business Opportunities ("[FedBizOpps](#)"). Other solicitations, especially those for professional service engagements or Building design and construction projects (including Architecture/Engineering acquisitions) issue Request for Information (RFI), Request for Proposal (RFP), and/or Request for Quotations (RFQ). These require written submission of proposals. GSA Public Buildings Service (PBS) contracting representatives are available to assist with these efforts.

The GSA Forecast of Contracting Opportunities is required by Public Law (PL) 100-656, the Business Opportunity Development Reform Act of 1988. The PL requires executive agencies to provide a forecast of all expected contracting opportunities, including those that small business and small disadvantaged business concerns are capable of performing. Continue to monitor our forecast data and Federal Business Opportunities (FedBizOpps) for upcoming opportunities.
