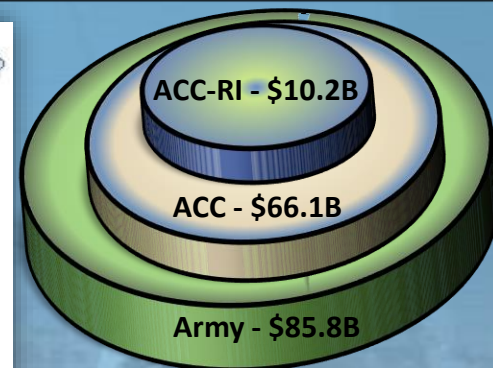
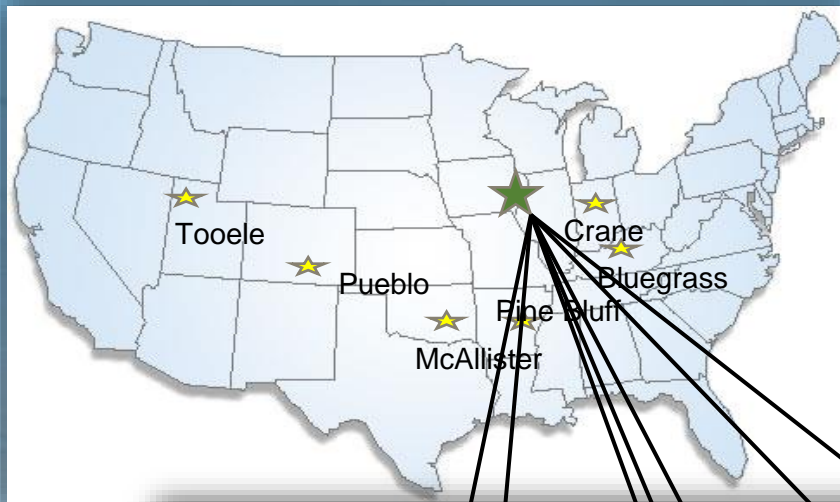

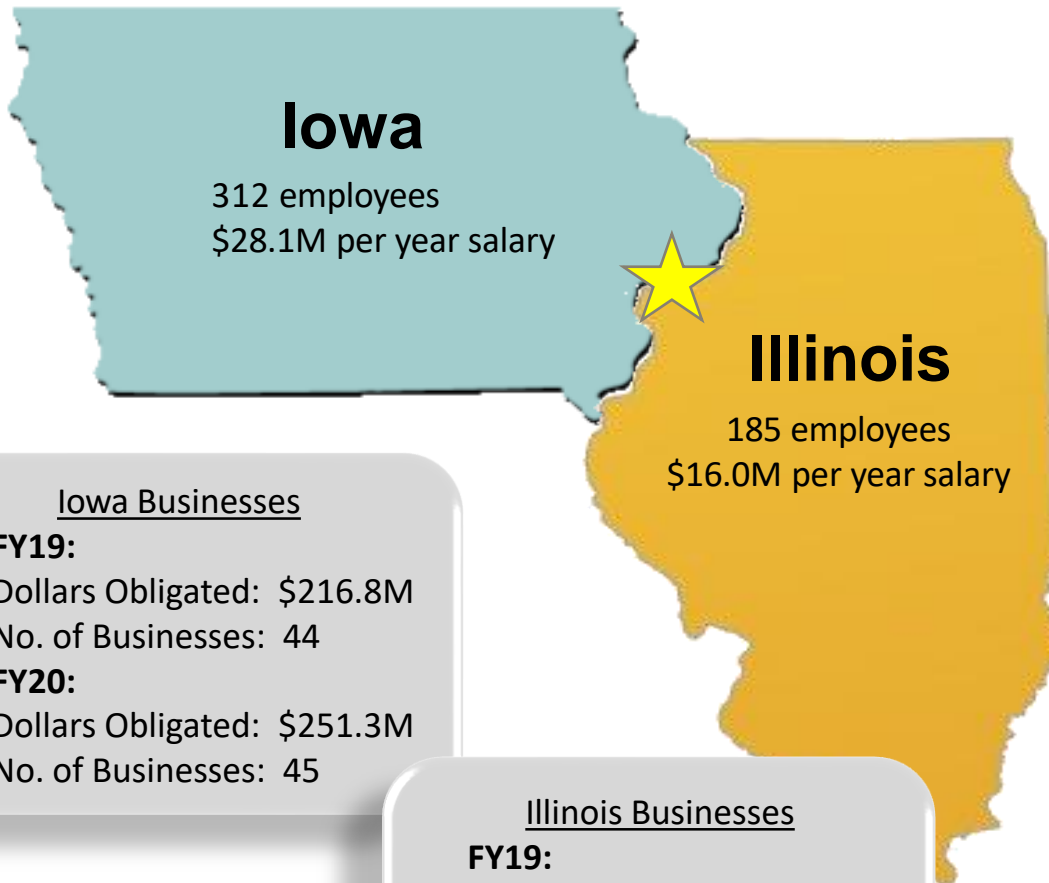
## What We Do

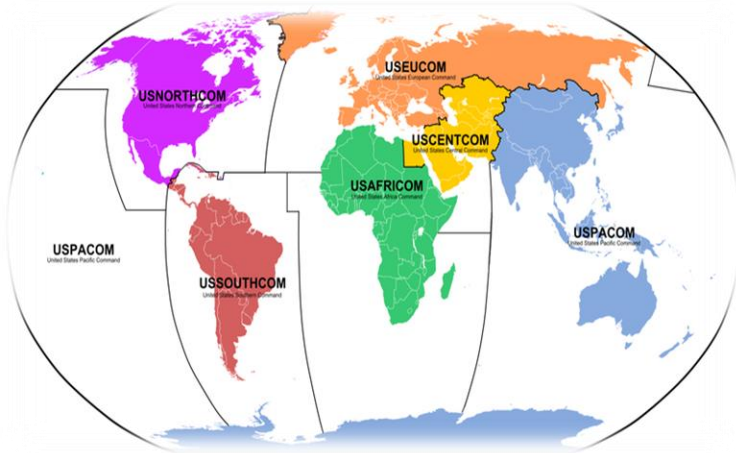

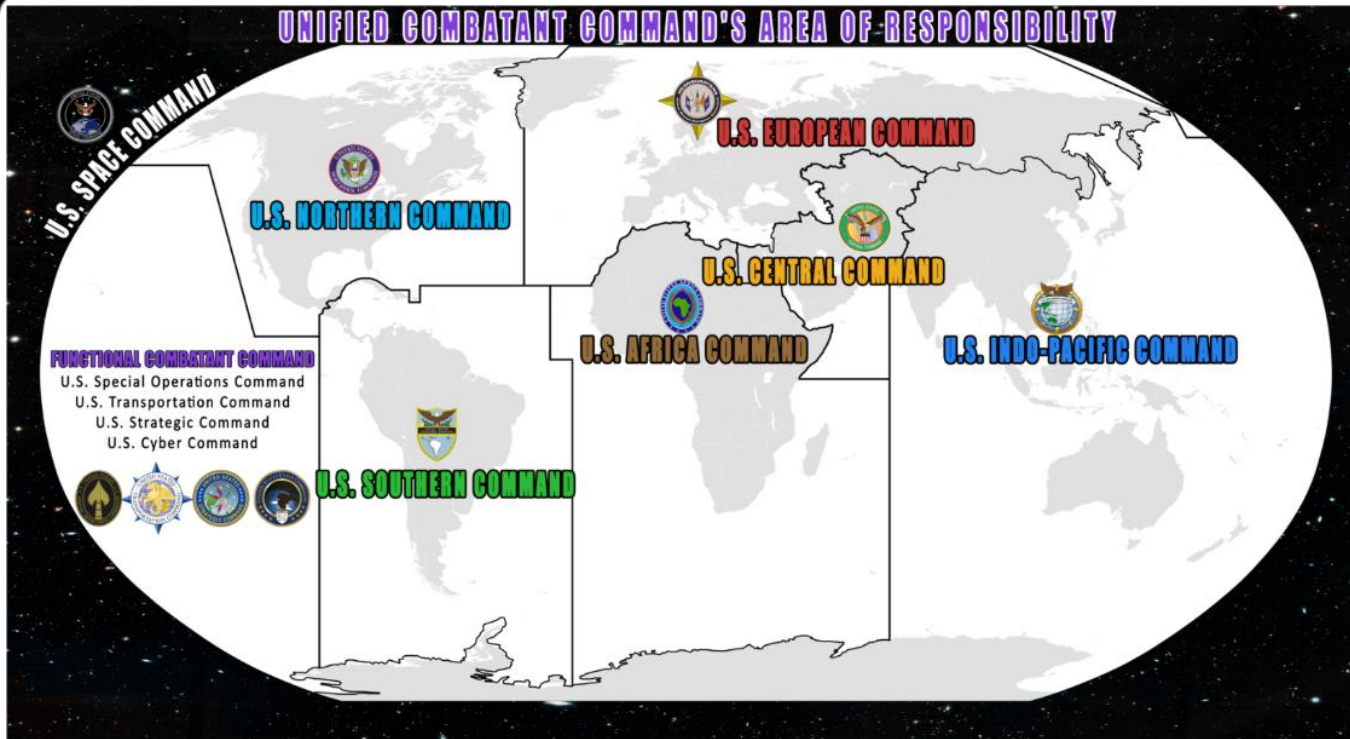

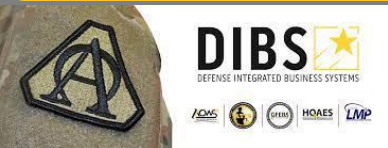
