Contractors and/or visitors are required to have a completed [Certification of Vaccination form](#) when entering a federal facility. If a contractor or visitor is not fully vaccinated, they must have in their possession documentation of a negative COVID-19 test result from an [FDA approved or authorized test](#) within the last 72 hours to show the FDA. If a contractor or visitor does not complete the form or is not in compliance with the building entry requirements referenced above, they will be denied access to the facility.
