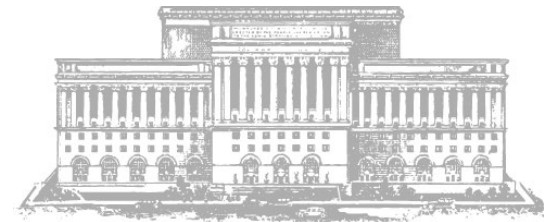

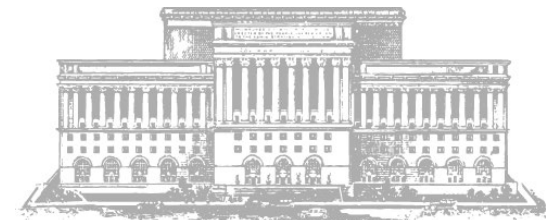

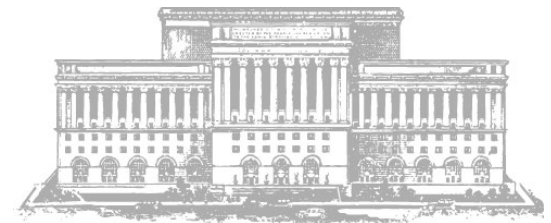


What Does Milwaukee County Buy?

- Identifies procurement opportunities within the County for minority- and women-owned and small business participation.

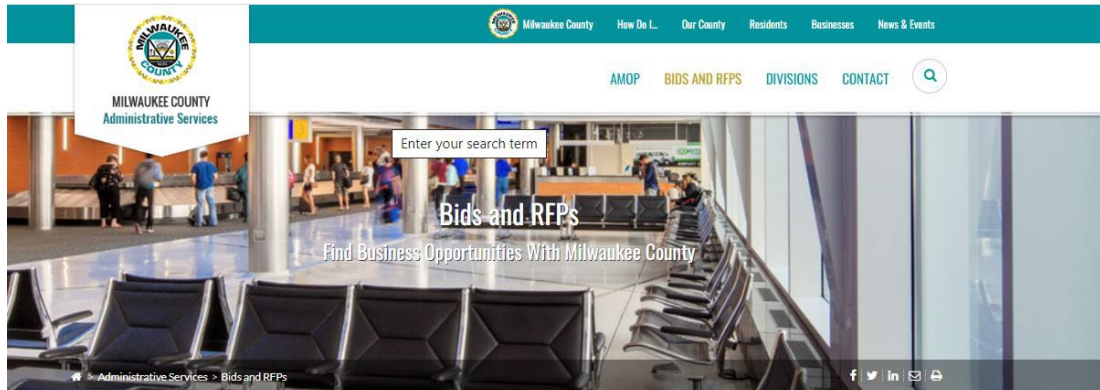

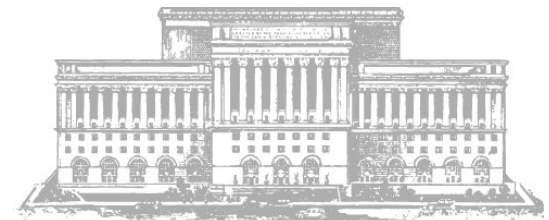
Certification Requirements

For projects that are fully funded by the FAA, FTA, or DOT, certified entities must qualify as:

- DBE
- ACDBE
- SBE

Criteria required by 49 CFR for certification:

- Be a for-profit business
- Be socially or economically disadvantaged
- Be a minority- or women-owned business having a minimum of 51% ownership
- Have control over business decisions
- Be a small-business enterprise according to SBA small business standards
- Have a personal net worth under \$1.32 million



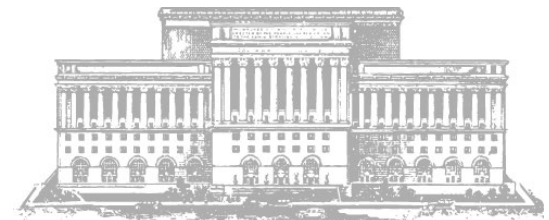


Certification Requirements

Most Milwaukee County contracts are not fully FAA, FTA or DOT funded.

Contracts without such funding require certification as a Targeted Business Enterprise:

- ACDBE/DBE/SBE certified by the WisUCP
- MBE certified as a minority-owned business with the State of Wisconsin DOA
- WBE certified as a women-owned business with the State of Wisconsin DOA
- SBE registered (by federal size standards, NAICS and registered in SAM)

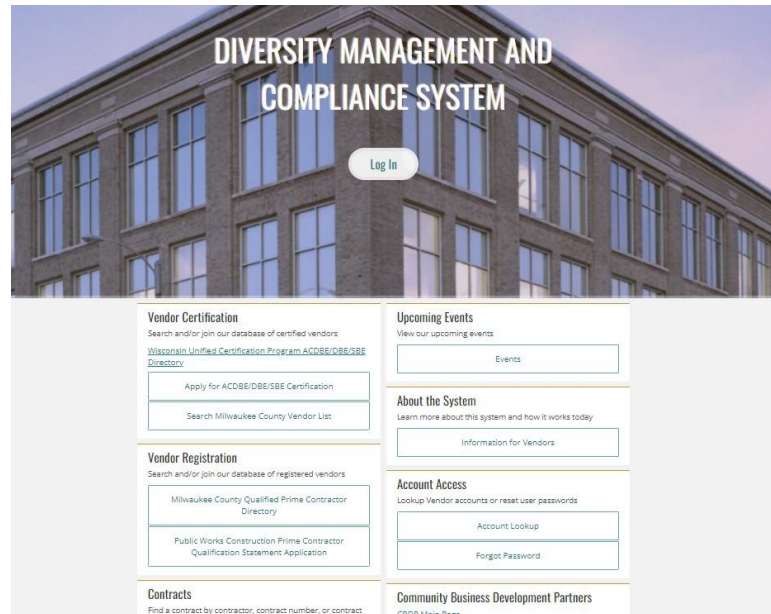
